
 Remittances will be mailed daily for refunds and weekly for medical record payments.

Pharmacy Coverage Changes





Nexium[®] and Adderall XR[®] Coverage Changes

Nexium – Only brand name covered while net cost of generic is higher. Blue Advantage® and BlueRx® plan members will continue to have Nexium covered at its current tier.

Adderall XR — Only brand name covered beginning May 1, 2015, while generics remain expensive due to patent litigations.








ICD-10

 Conversion was January 1, 2012. Although
 version 5010 accommodates the new code
 set, ICD-10* codes cannot be submitted
 until October 1, 2015.



- Send test claims in regular submission with other production claims or separately.
- Dates of service January 1, 2012, through the current date.

Send test claim(s) with dummy contracts

Receive test claim(s) acknowledgment through your audit report

View/validate results through *ProviderAccess*

ICD-10 End-to-End Testing

Sample End-to-End Timeline

 A test cycle is scheduled to be executed every two weeks.

Submit ICD-10 claims files to Blue Cross any time in the 2-week cycle

Send files by 3:30 p.m. Central Time Wednesday Blue Cross processes files Thursday-Friday (7 business days) Blue Cross returns results in Audit Report the next business day After 2-week cycle, test remittances are returned by 5 p.m. Central Time on Monday

Send test claims for eligible members only.

Files received after 3:30 p.m. Central Time on Wednesdays will be included in the next test cycle.


Receipt of the test claim will be acknowledged on the Audit Report as: "Special Handling Required at Payment Site for ICD-10."


All claims submitted within the 2-week cycle will be included in the bi-weekly test remittances.






Mobile App
